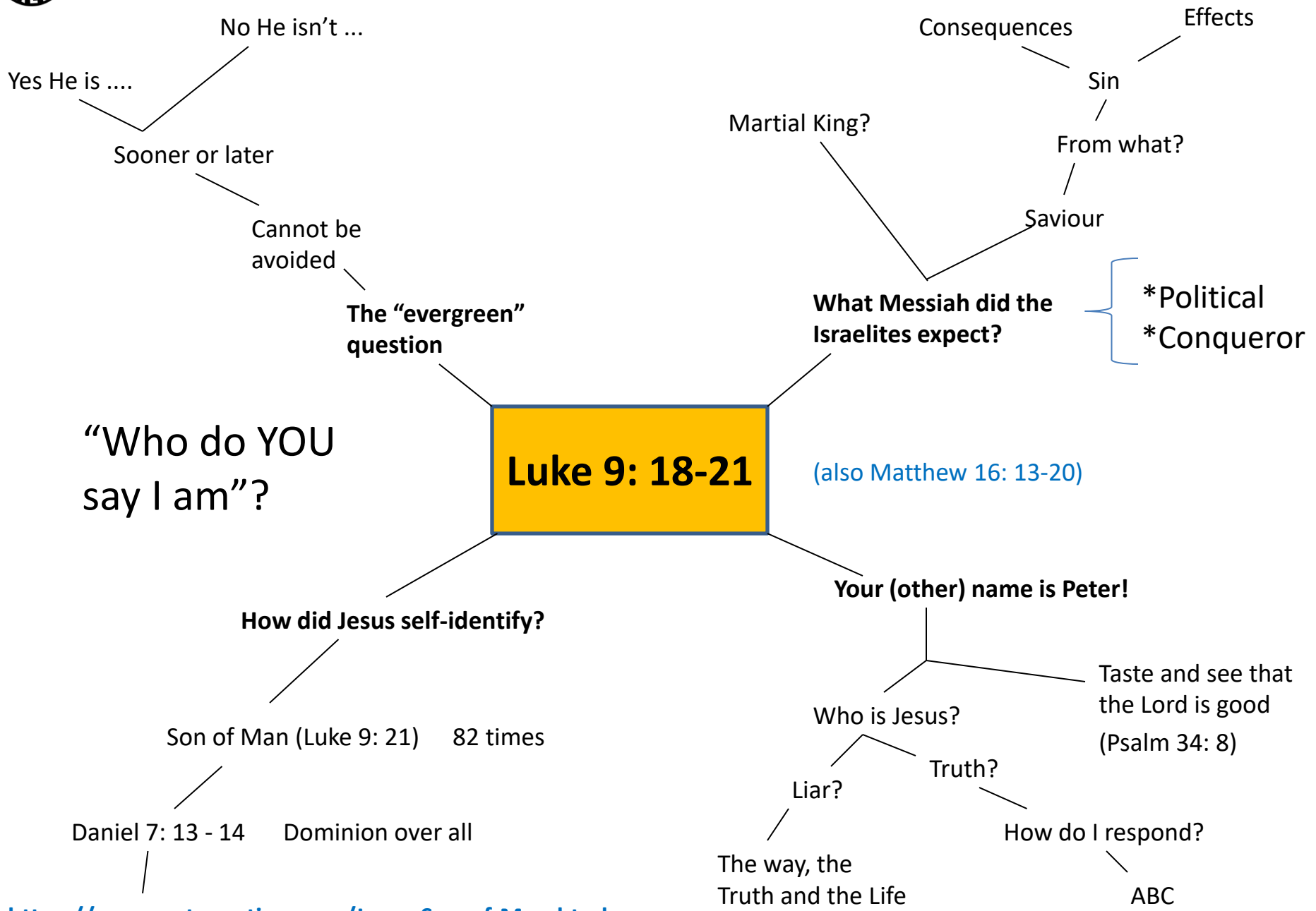




# THE PETER QUESTION (A.K.A. 'YOUR (OTHER) NAME IS PETER!')

# THE PETER QUESTION (A.K.A. 'YOUR (OTHER) NAME IS PETER!')

Jesus asked the disciples who is the Son of Man (Luke 9:20 ; Matthew 16: 15). Only Peter answered. Jesus asks you and me exactly the same question. As someone once said “you can run, but you can’t hide!”. You can run from the Peter question, but you can never (ever !) hide from it, or the consequences that flow from it.

## The Son of Man

*Son of God* reminds us of Jesus' divinity

*Son of Man* reminds us of Jesus' humanity

Daniel chapter 7 (esp v. 13-14 and 25-29) tells us of an eternal *Son of Man*, who Christians identify as being - prophetically - Jesus, Whose everlasting Kingdom cannot be destroyed.

Jesus used this title > 80 times to describe Himself. He knew He was (is !) the eternal Messiah.

Hence Matthew 26: 62-65 – the Jerusalem High Priest knew precisely what Jesus was saying.

## The Messiah (or 'Christ')

“You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God” (Matthew 16: 16)

Jesus is Messiah and Saviour. See John 3: 1 – 21). How do we respond to Jesus? We need to A ..... B ..... C .....
