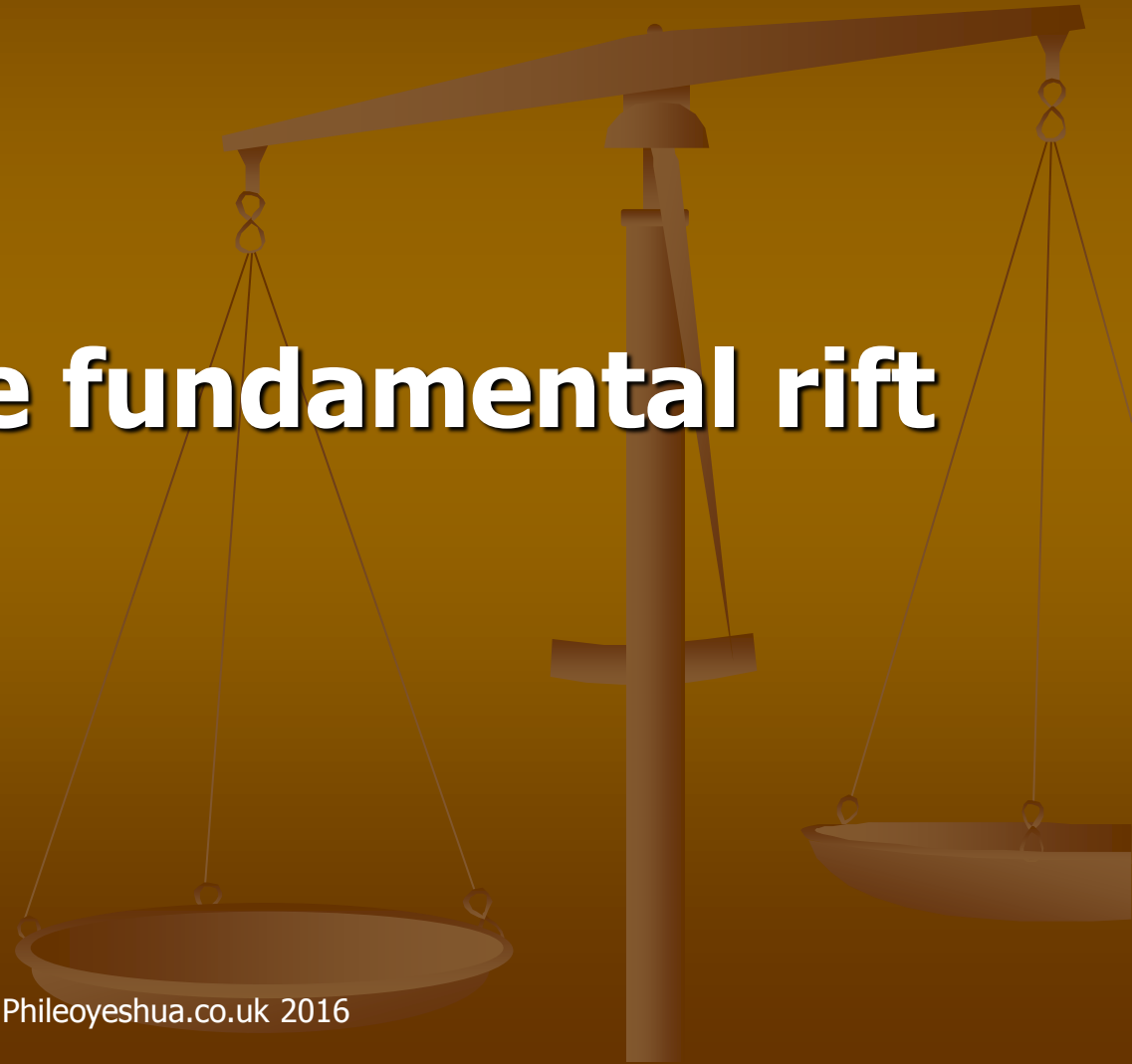

There are Jews and non-Jews.

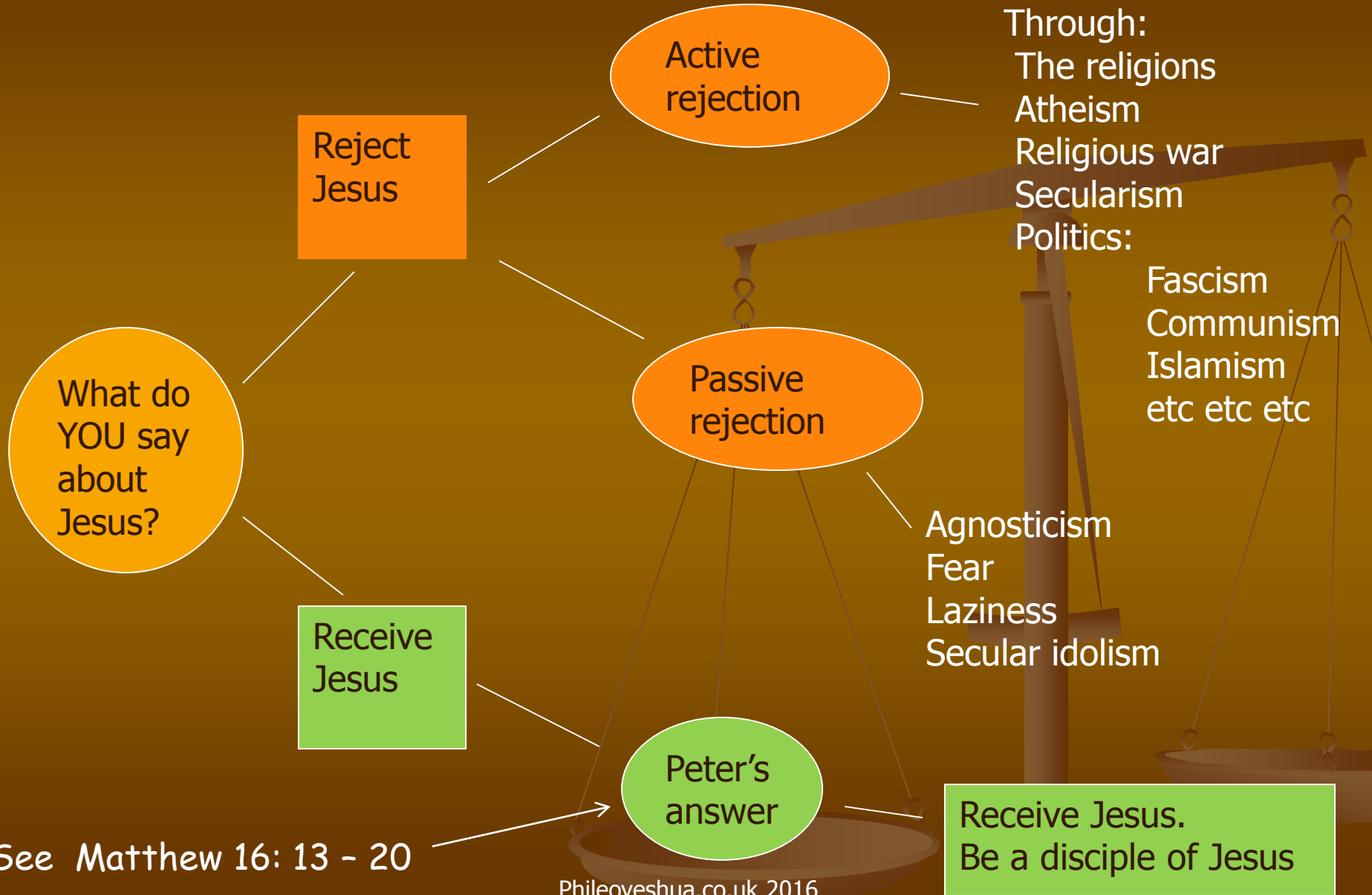
